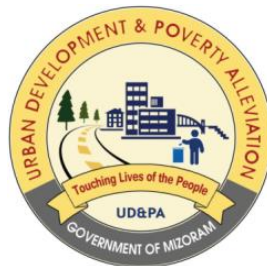

OVERVIEW OF ATAL MISSION FOR REJUVENATION AND URBAN TRANSFORMATION (AMRUT)

Atal Mission for Rejuvenation & Urban Transformation (AMRUT) was launched on the 25th June, 2015 by the Ministry of Urban Development (MoUD), Government of India with the aim to provide basic services to households and build amenities in urban areas to improve the quality of life for all the residents, especially the poor and disadvantaged.

Ministry of Urban Development selected the State capital city i.e., Aizawl for the State of Mizoram. MoUD has approved and allocated Rs. 140.247 crores under AMRUT for the state of Mizoram for the Mission period.

The following projects are completed during financial year 2020-2021:

1. Setting up of Septage Management Unit including Anaerobic Microbial Inoculum (AMI) & Bio Digester Manufacturing Facility at Aizawl under Septage management project (SAAP-I).
2. Pedestian, Non-Motorized and Public transport Facilities, parking Spaces in Aizawl City under urban transport project (SAAP-I).
3. Mission Vengthlang Eco - Park near Tlawng River under green space and parks project (SAAP-I).

Physical progress during financial year 2020-2021 is slower than expected due to spread of pandemic Covid-19 infection and continuous lockdown imposed in AMRUT City (i.e., Aizawl City).

UTILIZATION OF FUND RECEIVED UNDER REFORM INCENTIVE

- Rs. 100 lakhs are being utilized for construction of pedestrian footpath from Chaltlang to Chanmari received during 2015-16.
- Rs. 1.9 crores will be utilized for Street Renovation of Tennis Court Junction in Aizawl city.

AMRUT 2.0

1. Launched on 1st October, 2021 by Hon'ble Prime Minister.
2. It will cover all Urban Towns.
3. Approved outlay Rs. 2,99,000 Crores.
4. Rs. 142 crores have been allocated to Mizoram as admissible Central Assistance.
5. It will extend till 2025 – 2026.

Admissible components: -

- ❖ Universal coverage of Water Supply.
- ❖ Sewerage and Septage management (AMRUT City) and recycle / reuse of treated used water.
- ❖ Rejuvenation of water bodies and creation of green spaces.

Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed between Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs and Mizoram State. City water balance Plan (CWBP) was prepared and submitted for all Urban Towns (23 census Towns) on 31st January, 2022. City Water Action Plan (CWAP) is to be submitted to MoHUA.
